Stucco decorativo al Cocciopesto e grassello di calce

Stucco decorative lime plaster with cocciopesto– terracotta grains, combining the sfiammature effect typical of the cocciopesto and the lime putty translucent quality.



Cocciopesto

Decorative lime plaster with terracotta grains which combine to create the faded effect with the translucent quality of natural lime plasters. Cocciopesto is naturally low in VOCs and is mold resistant.

Surface preparation: It is recommended to apply over other natural lime surfaces, but it can also be applied after one coat of Primer S, on plaster, plaster by-products, or old paint, if surface is not cracked or peeling.

Application: Spread a coat of Cocciopesto with a stainless steel trowel so as to level the surface (Photo No. 2). Apply a second coat of Cocciopesto so as to obtain a perfectly smooth surface. Once the product is almost dry, compress slightly and polish with a clean stainless steel trowel so as to allow the shades deriving from the crushing of the Cocciopesto grains to appear. (Photo No. 3).

Cocciopesto: Available in: 1 Quart, 1 Gallon, 2 Gallons, & 4 Gallons pails.

Spread rate: 12 to 15 Sq. ft. per quart (2 coats).
